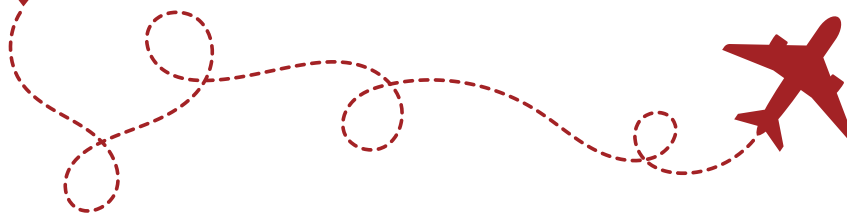

Take a scenic drive back to Paro, visit Wangdue Dzong, lunch by the road site restaurant, evening Paro town.

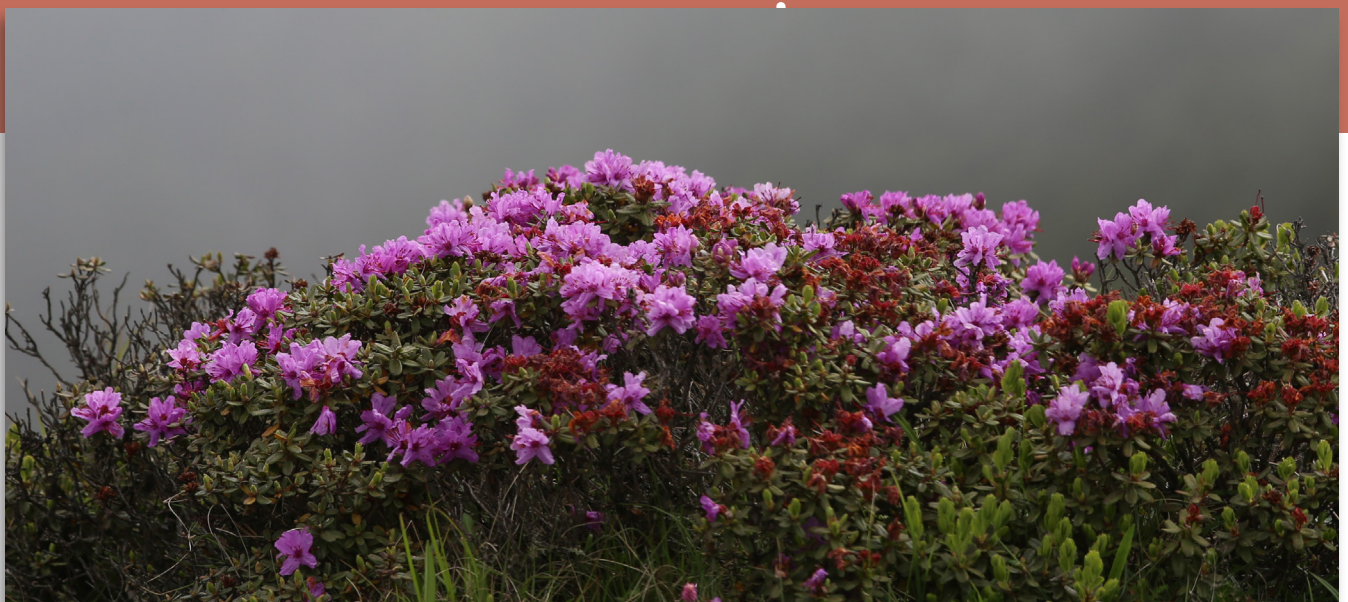
**Day 12:**
